General profile

- Every member is in a position to make an assessment of the main points of the policy of the Executive Board;
- Every member has wide experience in the non-profit sector, preferably in higher education and/or the arts;
- Every member contributes a worthwhile network and does his or her utmost to bring society and the arts closer together;
- In approaching candidates the endeavour is to achieve a spread across specific expertise so that the Board of Governors is able to assess the various parts of the policy of the Executive Board and is able to advise the Board;
- There should be a balance in the representation of the arts and culture, business and public sectors among the members;
- The Board of Governors is composed in such a way that the members can act independently and with a critical mind in relation to each other and the Executive Board and any vested interests.

- Member with affinity and wide experience in the arts and culture sector, also in an international context;
- Member with affinity and wide experience in higher (art) education, also in an international context;
- Member with affinity and wide experience in political, legal and administrative issues;
- Member with affinity and wide experience in financial (management) issues;
- Member with affinity and wide experience in architectural construction issues;
- The chairman of the Board of Governors is capable of directing all the relevant aspects of the overall process of supervision.
