

'Corona Addendum' to the Education and Examination Regulations (OER) of the Royal Conservatoire 2020/21

Article 1

This addendum enables the Executive Board of the University of the Arts The Hague to make a number of amendments to the Royal Conservatoire's Education and Examination Regulations during the corona pandemic. This document accords with the most recent Higher Education Service Document from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Science. The addendum was submitted to the Exam Committee and approved by the Study Programme Committee and the Faculty Council of Representatives.

Article 2

The Education and Examination Regulations 2020 – 2021 refers to the form of education and exams, which is further defined in the curriculum handbooks of the various programmes. The handbooks constitute an integral part of the Education and Examination Regulations. The addition of a 'hardship clause' establishes a basis for switching to online teaching and other forms of examination/methods of assessment in exceptional circumstances. This addendum declares the following hardship clause applicable:

'In situations of force majeure where it is not reasonably possible to provide the education and hold the examinations in the manner prescribed in the Education and Examination Regulations and the handbooks, another form of teaching and examination may be adopted temporarily. This is subject to the condition that, in the opinion of the exam committee, the defined learning objectives can still be attained on completion of the programme under the new format.'

Article 3

Substantial deviations to forms of education and examination and the accompanying guidelines and procedures relating to tests and assessments will be further elaborated on the basis of existing possibilities and submitted to the Study Programme Committee and the Exam Committee and notified to the students by the heads of the departments.

Article 4: Contingencies

Decisions on situations not provided for in this addendum that require an immediate reaction or urgent action will be made by the management of the Royal Conservatoire, after consultation with the Exam Committee, the Study Programme Committee and the Faculty Council of Representatives.

Article 5: Entry into force, citation title and publication

This addendum applies for the 2020 – 2021 academic year and can be cited as 'Corona addendum to the Education and Examination Regulations of the Royal Conservatoire 2020 - 2021'. The addendum will be published on the website koncon.nl and on the Royal Conservatoire's intranet.
